COURT REFERRED DRIVER IMPROVEMENT COURSE.

Refund Policy and Fees

If you paid in advance for a court referred driver improvement course for you or the student and wish to cancel, you can receive a full refund as long as you notify us at least one business day in advance of the scheduled course. You will need to call the office or email a request to cancel. Cancelling without notice of at least one business day prior to course will result in a \$35 fee. Keep in mind, if timing is a problem, you can always change the date of the course to another date and apply your payment.

NMAC Driving Safety School Rules require a student to complete the entire course hours required by the courts, typically a minimum of 6 or 8-hours. The student must pass the final exam with a minimum of 70% correct in order to receive the Certificate of Completion. Should a student fail to pass the final exam with a minimum of 70% correct, the student may schedule a time to retake the exam at no additional charge.

Should weather conditions of any kind cause hazardous road conditions restricting transportation, classes will be cancelled. The student may opt for a full refund or reschedule for the next available class.
